



Yuma Radne (b. 2001, Ulaan Ude) started painting from an early age and enrolled in an art school from the age of 5. Having started developing her own style, she began having her first appearance in local newspapers as a teenager. When Yuma was 16, she dropped out of school and began painting full-time. Radne held her first solo show at the National Museum of Buryatia in 2018, being 17, and soon after she moved to Saint Petersburg to study monumental painting in Stiglitz Academy. In 2019 the artist had rejected the traditional way of education there and flew to Austria, where she studied painting in the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna. After living there for almost 5 years, she did an exchange year at Slade School of Art, and stayed in London after that. Lives and works in London.
